

2025 Notice of Assessment Information

The annual Notice of Assessment will be mailed to all owners of real property in Coweta County on June 20, 2025. This document provides notice of the value placed on your real property and is not a tax bill.

The Notice includes prior and current year values, notation of any applicable exemptions and an estimated tax based on the previous year's millage rate.

This Notice is not a property tax bill. Property tax bills will be mailed in October.

MANDATED STATE CHANGES

As a result of recent changes in State law and policies established by the Georgia Department of Revenue, this year's Notice of Assessment appears different from previous years, to include the following:

- The Notice only includes maintenance and operations (M&O) tax levies for the taxing authorities (see box #1 below). Therefore, only the County M&O, School M&O, and applicable municipal levies are included. Special service districts (Countywide 911, Fire District, etc.), are not included on the Notice but all tax levies and associated millage rates will be listed on the 2025 property tax bill, coming out in October.
- The Homestead Exemption Value (see box #2 below) includes the total value for the standard exemption and the new floating exemption based on House Bill 581. Please note, the School Board opted out of HB581 so the Homestead Exemption Value in this row will not include a floating exemption value.
- The Estimated Tax (see box #3 below) is based on the 2024 millage rate and has little bearing on 2025. Rather, as in the past, the 2025 property tax bills will result from each levying authority adopting 2025 millage rates in August that will be applied to the assessed value.

If the Homestead cell is listed as "No" on your Notice (see box #4 below), please contact the Assessors Office to check your exemption eligibility.

If you disagree with the Current Year Fair Market Value on the Notice of Assessment, you can file an appeal online or in-person. The deadline to file an appeal is Monday, August 4. Learn more about the appeal process here: https://bit.ly/CowetaAppeals.

The amount of your ad valorem tax bill for the year shown above will be based on the Appraised (100%) and Assessed (40%) values specified in BOX '8' of this notice. You have the right to submit an appeal regarding this assessment to the County Board of Tax Assessors. If you wish to file an appeal, you must do so in writing no later than 45 days after the date of this notice. If you do not file an appeal by this date, your right to file an appeal will be lost. Appeal forms which may be used are available at http://dor.georgia.gov/documents/property-tax-appeal-assessment-form.

At the time of filing your appeal you must select one of the following appeal methods:

- (1) County Board of Equalization (value, uniformity, denial of exemption, or taxability)
- (2) Arbitration (value)
- (3) County Hearing Officer (value or uniformity, on non-homestead real property or wireless personal property valued, in excess of \$500,000)

All documents and records used to determine the current value are available upon request.
